Joint CA 261 CARB Report

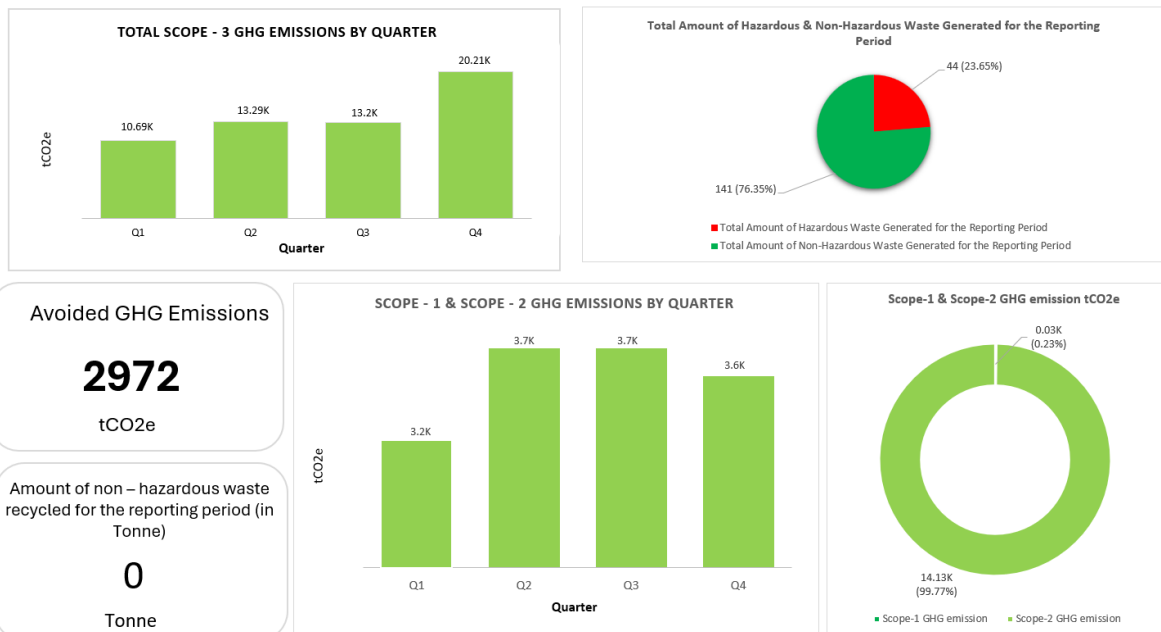
OMH-HealthEdge Holdings, Inc. dba Omega Healthcare Management Services® (“Omega Healthcare”) and Omega Whitespace Health LLC (“WSH”) (collectively “Omega”) present this Joint 261 CARB Report regarding Green House Gas (“GHG”) emissions.

Omega is a leading provider of technology-enabled revenue cycle management (“RCM”) solutions and services that support a stronger patient experience and enhance financial performance for health systems, hospitals, physician groups and payers. Our mission is to improve the effectiveness and accessibility of healthcare by empowering providers and payers to better serve their patients and insureds.

We advance this mission through our commitment to clients and their patients, expanded access to care, innovation, our workforce and communities, ethical conduct, and environmental responsibility. Our Environmental, Social, and Governance (“ESG”) strategy aligns with leading external frameworks, including the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (“UN SDGs”), the Sustainability Accounting Standards Board (“SASB”) Standards, and the Task Force on Climate-Related Financial Disclosures (“TCFD”) recommendations.

Regarding its CA 261 reporting obligations, Omega has less than USD\$50M in revenues in the state of California. Omega has no physical operations in the State of California and generates all revenues from outsourced employees working either remotely in California, other U.S. state locations, or in offshore locations, such as India, Philippines, or Colombia. Collectively, Omega only has a total of USD\$2.5M in salaries in California.
